


Mbi Music 2023 Annual Report

MESSAGE FROM FOUNDER



This is our first annual report as Mbi Music. We started operations in 2021 working with St Anthony's Child and Youth Care Centre in KwaZUlu Natal, South Africa to provide 20 children with musical instruments and lessons. In May 2022, we established our partnership with Les Saints Innocents, currently 17 children signed up for the program in rural Zinaire, Burkina Faso. In 2023, we started exploring options for projects in Nigeria and Zimbabwe, with local partners.

As founder of Mbi Music, this annual report is timely to show not only a dream I had but the commitment of the advisory team - moninga team - and the generosity of our donors which are all critical to providing vulnerable children with the possibility to dream, heal and grow through music.

During my first visit to KwaZulu Natal in Oct 2023, I was submerged with emotions because up till then, I did not think I realised how important the work we are doing since the launch of Mbi-Music. Spending time with the kids at Saint Anthony's child & youth care centre was a unique experience. I am grateful and amazed to see how my dream at 13 years old is now a reality and also giving opportunities to many underprivileged young people in different settings in African countries. We have just started.

It took me most of my life to realise my childhood dream of helping children in distress but I have to say this realisation is beyond my own work. Some dreams need the support of other people to happen - I am lucky enough to be surrounded by amazing, kind, generous human beings - moninga team - who are willing to make our world a better place for children. I am even more proud today as the logo of Mbi-Music was designed by my son, at 12 years of age.

To all our donors throughout the years, thank you for believing in our dream and supporting our work.

Children need love, care, and opportunities and that's exactly what we are doing with Mbi-Music - a Charity through musical notes.

SAINT ANTHONY'S HOME SOUTH AFRICA

Saint Anthony's Child and Youth Care Center is a registered non-profit organization that accommodates 100 children. It provides an environment that will allow the child to heal from the past experiences, reflect on the past, realise their potential, strength & will power. The staff at Saint Anthony's work tirelessly to bring back hope to the children under their care and provides them with extra opportunities to realise their true existence. The centre has operated for more than 50 years and the management of the facility is in accordance with the Children's Act. In 2002, the Home appointed its first secular Director, Mbongiseni Petrus Nzuza. Under his direction St. Anthony's Home has continued to grow, always recognising the need for development and transformation, thus accommodating the ever changing needs of the children, families and communities we support.

- Hours of lessons provided: 4 hours / week (2h Satursday & 2h Sunday)

Actions Achieved in 2023:

- Mbi-Music participated in the 60th anniversary of St Anthony's Child and Youth Care Centre.
- The children performed with the instruments donated in front of the 100+ guests
- An additional two full drumkits were donated to the children.








Mbi-Music Projects

ORPHANAGE LES SAINTS INNOCENTS BURKINA FASO

Sisters of the Immaculate Conception of Ouagadougou opened on June 9th 2002, their first center for orphan children called "Orphanage Les Saints Innocents" (CAED LSI). This orphanage has a capacity of 120 children. Its main mission is to welcome vulnerable children in distress, regardless of social class and religious affiliation. It offers its residents access to education, ensures their safety, their health and their food. Another major objective set by the CAED LSI is to help reduce juvenile delinquency and facilitate the social integration of these children. 426 children have stayed there since its creation and Sister Françoise is the current head of the center. A school takes place within the orphanage with 500 students aged from 2 to 14 years old, from the orphanage and from the village without discrimination.



Support provided by Mbi-Music:

- Instruments donated: Guitars (5), Keyboards (2), Flutes (5) & Djembe Drums (5)
- Name of Teacher: Pierre
- Hours of lessons provided: 2 hours / week

Actions Achieved in 2023:

- Sourcing of instruments and the start of classes in May 2023.
- Provision of meals for the children during classes of October and t-shirts for Christmas.
- Children prepared a Christmas concert in front of a big audience.










Total Expenditure

Our goal with Mbi-Music is to reach orphans and underprivileged children and give them opportunities to make their dreams a reality. Mbi-Music reaches underprivileged children and orphans of any age and offers them a 360-degree music programme. Through music, we give them opportunities that will allow them to become independent in realising their dreams.

OUR CHARITY ORGANISATION.

Our international association, without any religious or political purpose, aims to support disadvantaged children and teenagers, without any discrimination, through a 360° music programme through instruments, dance, singing, DJ production, etc.

It is based on the volunteering of supervisors, allowing social actions in the training and the supporting projects of these children and teenagers, using discovery workshops, courses, concerts, connections with professionals, the organisation of shows and performances, the loan of material, instruments...

Actions will be implemented to finance the programmes of the association, namely:

- Donations (including in-kind contributions)
- Subsidies from the State, departments and municipalities (country of registration).
